...an opportunity for home owners, farmers, and businesses to properly dispose of unwanted our out-dated ag chemicals.

Who can participate?

Fond du Lac Co. farmers may dispose of out-dated or unwanted chemicals at NO COST but must pre-register (see below).

Fond du Lac Co. businesses, government departments, and schools using or retailing pesticides are eligible for a subsidy from WDATCP to dispose of ag pesticides. Eligible businesses include:

- Abandoned business sites
- Aerial applicators
- Ag chemical suppliers
- Golf courses
- Landscape contractors
- Structural pest control companies
- Turf managers
- Veterinarians

Businesses interested in participating in the program must contact the Fond du Lac Co. Extension office at least one week prior to the clean sweep date.

Examples of chemicals accepted

Pesticides

2,4-D
2,4,5-T

Unknown Chemicals

Ag Clean Sweep will accept most unknown chemicals. If you have over 50 lbs. or 5 gallons of unknown chemicals, please let us know when you pre-register.

Drums

Ag Clean Sweep accepts 30- and 55-gallon drums, but this must be noted at pre-registration.

Chemicals/Products NOT Accepted

Latex or oil paint, used oil/kerosene, compressed gas cylinders, explosives, Freon 11 and 12, infectious and biological wastes, and radioactives

Pre-registration by phone is mandatory for farms: Call the Fond du Lac Co. UW Extension office no later than **Friday, October 30th** (920-929-3171, Ripon: 920-748-7565). When you call, be prepared to answer some general questions about what you are bringing (pesticide or other chemical), and how much (lbs. and/or gallons). **You do not have to pre-register if only bringing household/yard hazardous wastes.**

Note: Disposal funds are limited. If you don't pre-register, there is a chance you will be turned away.
