GET CHECKING is designed for people who currently don't have an account with a financial institution or want to learn more about their current account.

Maybe you have never had an account and don't know how to start. Maybe you have had problems with an account in the past that are making it difficult to open an account now. Or, maybe you want more information about managing your current account.

GET CHECKING offers you the opportunity to open an account with a participating financial institution even if you have had problems in the past.

What You Will Learn

- How to choose an account that is right for you, including:
 - ◆ Low cost checking options.
 - ◆ How to avoid costly fees.
- What you need to know to keep your checking account in balance.
- How your account relationship can help you establish credit and access other services.

Will I Be Able To Open An Account After the Class?

When you have completed the GET CHECKING program, you will receive a certificate. To open an account, take your certificate and proper identification to a participating financial institution.

If you have outstanding fees from a prior account, we suggest you settle that account before opening a new one. Institutions are not required to open an account if there has been evidence of fraud on a prior account.
