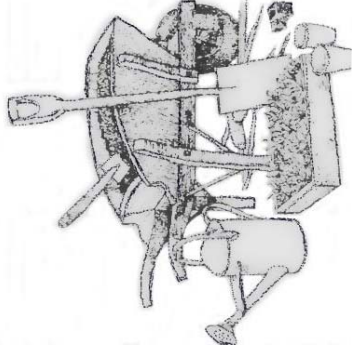

We'll discuss some of the toughest, low-maintenance, yet beautiful perennials for sun, part-sun and shade.*

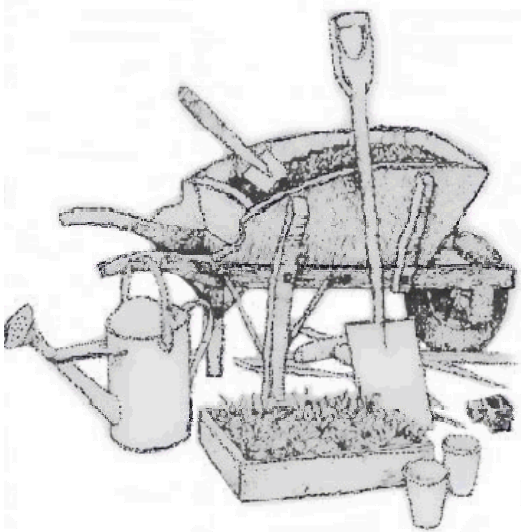
